Cause and effect are about how one thing can cause something else to happen.

The **cause** is *why* something happened.

The **effect** is *what* happened.

Here are some examples of **cause and effect**. Circle the most likely **cause** of each thing that happened.

Why did Leo take off his sweatshirt?	Leo felt warm.
	Leo was hungry.

2. Why did Dominic wash his hands?	Dominic was looking at a picture book.
	Dominic's hands were dirty.

3. Why did Claire get a glass of water?	Claire was taking a nap.
	Clare was thirsty.

4. Why did Jordan turn on the light?	The room was cold.
	The room was dark.

5. Why did Patrice put on her mittens?	It was cold outside.
	It was raining outside.
